# **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

A hardy group of people braved the weather to attend the HARA Annual General Meeting in February. Apart from hearing from the outgoing committee and electing a new committee for 2016, we had a very interesting talk from Inspector Simon Reid about recent changes to the Police Scotland structure in Aberdeenshire and an update on policing matters pertaining to Hatton.

Other issues raised by those attending the AGM included the perennial request for some form of crossing at the A90 junction to enable people to safely cross to and from the bus stop at the Station Hotel side of the road; and the equally recurring issue of drivers ignoring the speed limits within the village, particularly coming downhill on Main Street. HARA will be speaking yet again to BEAR regarding some form of traffic management on the A90 and to the Council's Roads Department about conducting another traffic survey within the village.

Fred Coutts agreed to continue as Newsletter Editor and Webmaster.

This Autumn will be the 20th Anniversary since HARA was founded (originally as HAFRA - Hatton Farm Residents Association) and we will be looking at organising something special in the way of a celebration. Ideas welcome!

The new committee will also be looking at organising another Village Litterpick come the Spring and some other fund raising and informative activities over the Spring and Summer months. Once an electrician is able to attend and install the defibrillator we have acquired for the village, which is to be sited at the Hall, we will be looking at some training on its use and basic first aid, possibly jointly with the Hall Committee.

## **Training in CPR**

Our village Public Access Defibrillator (PAD) has recently been fitted to the Village Hall, just right of the entrance doors. The PAD is inside the briefcase-sized Green Box and is available to anyone in the event of an emergency.

When a heart stops beating (cardiac arrest) every minute without CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) and defibrillation reduces the chance of survival by 10 per cent.

If someone suffers a cardiac arrest, call 999, the operator will remind you that there is Public Access Defibrillator nearby and give you a code to open its door. You should send someone else to fetch it. Once you have the defibrillator, open it and follow the spoken instructions that the machine will give you.

HARA recognises that many people in the village would feel more confident in using the PAD if training in CPR and the use of the PAD was available.

Peterhead Fire and Rescue Services Team have kindly offered to come to the hall and give short training sessions. These will be free of charge. However before the training sessions can be organised we need to know the number of people that would be interested. We will then arrange suitable dates and times.
