RAILWAY LINE FOOTPATH

The feasibility study to convert the disused railway line to a footpath has now been completed. HARA now has an accurate measurement for the path along with an accurate estimated cost. Unfortunately, though we had hoped to be making an application for funding at this point, the bad news is that the source of funding we were relying on was via the European Parliament. Sadly this is no longer available. Most people will understand why. We are therefore looking at alternative funders to raise the £191,000 required. This will take some time.

HARA would like to extend its thanks to all those individuals and groups that have written letters of support. These will remain extremely important in our efforts and we would ask anyone that still wants to support us to please continue to do so in writing. PLAY PARK EQUIPMENT

Although HARA has secured funding for the new equipment, Aberdeenshire Council is unable to install on land that does not belong to them. HARA is therefore currently seeking additional funding for the £7000 installation costs, which will now be done by the company supplying the goods.

- Child health concerns; school bus diesel fumes

The Parish of Cruden – Church of Scotland

The Manse, Main Street, Hatton, AB42 0QQ

Dear Friends,

I am writing to introduce myself as the new parish minister for Hatton & Cruden Bay. Working out of the Hatton Manse on Main Street, my role is to offer a mainstream and inclusive Christian ministry for church members and local residents. This is what makes the Church of Scotland so distinctive. We are a national church with a grass roots presence. I also hope that in developing a close working relationship with other local churches, people of faith of all denominations can be a source of unity and blessing to the wider community.

So what is your new parish minister like? I am in my late fifties and originally from Derbyshire. During my time at Aberdeen University I met and married Alison who is currently minister of Barthol Chapel linked with Tarves. We have two Golden Retrievers – Calvin who is ten years old and well behaved and an eleven week old not very well behaved puppy called Melville (and other names!). Before entering the ministry, I worked as a chef and catering manager. My experience of ministry also includes almost twenty-five years serving communities as diverse as west-end Aberdeen, rural Aberdeenshire and an urban priority housing scheme. I have also served as Chaplain to the Army Cadet Force, Territorial Army and Air Training Corps, and been involved in Scouts and Boys' Brigade.

Outside my church work, I have a keen interest in running and fitness. I regularly take part in events from 5k up to full marathons and am involved as a Jogleader with Jogscotland and an activity leader with Aberdeenshire Council Active Schools. My interest in fitness had led me to becoming a qualified gym and fitness instructor, although I am not leading any groups at present. I also enjoy rowing and hill walking, good films, fine malt whisky and chilling out in our touring caravan. On the negative side, I don't have a good memory for names, my hand writing is illegible, and I possess a rather mischievous sense of humour.

I am aware the Parish of Cruden has a long history that can be traced out back to 1012 AD with the ancient Kirk of Cruden being

dedicated to St Olaf, patron saint of Norway and Denmark. The current building is conveniently situated between Hatton and Cruden Bay and dates from 1776, possibly the third building on the current site. More recently the church has experienced a long five-year vacancy since the retirement of my much loved and respected predecessor, Rev Roger Neilson. It is a tribute to the congregation and volunteers that during those five years they have not lost heart but have risen to the challenge.

So what about the future? Before I personally can look ahead there is much I need to learn about the congregation and local communities. However, irrespective of how our paths cross, I do hope your local parish Kirk will be seen as welcoming, hospitable and outward looking.




Hatton Baby and Toddler Group




